New Business

Memorial Bricks

- A program was started in 1994 to place a Memorial Brick at the Greater Cleveland Peace Officers Memorial site for every deceased member Chief. No member Chiefs deceased prior to 1994 had bricks placed and in the ensuing years several Chiefs have been overlooked. President Maine and Executive Director Bruckner recommend that this oversight be rectified with the placement of memorial bricks for ALL deceased member Chiefs. *Motion to approve the placement of memorial bricks for all deceased member Chiefs as currently listed in our roster of Deceased Chief Members in an amount not to exceed \$3,500.00 made by Chief Dease and seconded by Chief Brosius. Motion passed.*

(NOTE) Subsequent research disclosed that 59 deceased member chiefs do not have a memorial brick in place. Bricks are added each May. An order for the bricks will be placed in April, 2009 for placement in May 2009.

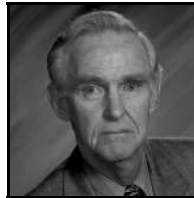
